Rick received a B.A. in history from the University of California while Brunetta earned a certificate in orthopedics at the U.C. Med School in San Francisco. After graduation, he advanced in radio from Deejay to Radio Reporter, News Director, and then TV Reporter. In Texas and New Mexico, he worked at radio stations in Amarillo, Marshall, Sherman, Tyler, and Clovis. Later he taught radio news while completing his masters in Communication at Southern Miss. (M.S., '72).

In '74, the 97th U.S. Army Reserve Command in Salt Lake City recruited him to be their full-time civilian Public Information Officer. A neighbor, Congressman Dan Marriott asked him to join his staff in Washington in 1979. After much prayer, he and Brunetta were off to D.C., where Brunetta found a position in Sen. Bob Dole's office. Eventually, both landed in the first Reagan Administration. Rick was a speechwriter for Dorcas Hardy, the Assistant Secretary of Health and Human Services, and Brunetta became a secretary for ACTION Agency Director (and Texan) Tom Pauken.

In 1984, Rick returned to Career Federal Service. He temporarily served as Chief of the News Division at USDA while the Reagan Administration sought a permanent appointee, then joined the Features Division of the Voice of America (VOA).

After three years at VOA, Rick was asked by the Deputy Administrator of the Federal Transit Administration to help with speechwriting during the senior Bush administration. Meanwhile, Brunetta had joined the Department of Justice, where she worked in the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Programs.

Two of Rick's speeches earned second place in International Mercury Awards speechwriting competition. He won numerous speechwriting awards from the National Association of Government Communicators (NAGC), competing against entries from all levels of government. In addition, one of his VOA radio programs won a Gold Screen award from the NAGC.

When the Clinton Administration began moving Conservatives out of policy-making positions, Rick was offered the chance to move to Fort Worth in 1993 where he and Brunetta are active in the Republican Party. Rick was a Bush-Cheney Team Leader, who joined other local GOP activists to help Pete Sessions implement the Martin Frost Retirement Plan. Rick and Brunetta are founding donors and Burke Society members of the Leadership Institute, which they describe as the foremost training organization for young conservatives. LI's Congressional Advisory Board Members include Pete Sessions, John Cornyn, Ralph Hall, and Tom DeLay, among others. Rick retired from the Army Reserve with the rank of major. His awards include the Army Commendation Medal with two Oak Leaf Clusters and the Meritorious Service Medal.

There is a new book that every God-fearing and Patriotic American needs to be aware of.

CAIR BACKS FATWA AGAINST TERROR

English, Arabic, Urdu radio anti-terror PSAs released (reproduced by permission of the Council on American-Islamic Relations)

(WASHINGTON, D.C., 7/28/05)

- The Council on American-Islamic Relations (CAIR) today offered its support for a fatwa, or Islamic religious ruling, against terrorism and extremism issued by the Fiqh Council of North America (FCNA) and endorsed by more than 120 U.S. Muslim groups, leaders and institutions. (The term "fiqh" refers to Islamic jurisprudence.)

The fatwa, released during a news conference this morning at the National Press Club in Washington, D.C., states in part: "Islam strictly condemns religious extremism and the use of violence against innocent lives. There is no justification in Islam for extremism or terrorism. Targeting civilians' life and property through suicide bombings or any other method of attack is haram - or forbidden - and those who commit these barbaric acts are criminals, not 'martyrs'. In the light of the teachings of the Qur'an and Sunnah we clearly and strongly state: 1. All acts of terrorism targeting civilians are haram (forbidden) in Islam. 2. It is haram for a Muslim to cooperate with any individual or group that is involved in any act of terrorism or violence. 3. It is the civic and religious duty of Muslims to cooperate with law enforcement authorities to protect the lives of all civilians. We issue this fatwa following the guidance of our scripture, the Qur'an, and the teachings of our Prophet Muhammad - peace be upon him."

In a statement read at the news conference, CAIR Executive Director Nihad Awad said: "United, we can confront the terrorists and frustrate their goal of sparking an apocalyptic war between faiths and civilizations. . .The presence here today of American Muslim leaders indicates the willingness of our community to strengthen national security and to work with policy-makers to gain victory over this international menace to humanity." CAIR urged that the fatwa be read by Imams, or Islamic prayer leaders, at Friday prayers across the United States.

Awad also announced the release of radio versions of CAIR's 30-second "Not in the Name of Islam" television public service announcement (PSA) in English, Arabic and Urdu.
